HBRS Guidelines External Reviewers

The external examiner should be chosen carefully. He/she must be independent. Here we list some criteria for the **exclusion** of an examiner*.

Criteria for excluding an examiner:

- 1. First-degree relative of the supervisor or student.
- 2. Current or planned cooperation.
- 3. Dependent employment or supervisory relationship (e.g. supervisor-student relationship including Postdoc time) up to six years after termination of any such relationship.
- 4. Scientific co-operations in the past three years e.g. joint publications.

Criteria to be evaluated by the PhD committee:

- 4. Persons with relationships, which are not first-degree, but personal or conflicting with any of the involved parties.
- 5. Persons who plan to move to the MHH or partner institutes in the Region Hannover soon and with strong relationship to the supervisor.
